Tasting Notes

- An enticing rich purple, this lesser known Northern Italian red varietal is best known as the nephew of a French variety that was the parent of Syrah. This unique red wine has aromas of red rose petals, red currant, and red raspberry that abound from the glass. The pallet has bright red fruit notes including raspberry, red cherry and anise with savory hints of slate and oyster shell on the finish. The fine tannins and bright acidity on the finish make this an extremely food friendly wine.

Winemakers Notes

- Punch down fermentation method was used with a moderate to short maceration time of 18 days on skins. This 100% Teroldego was aged for 8 months in 50% French and 50% American Oak to enhance the tannin mouthfeel.
